CATTLE FROM ACCREDITED HERDS ONLY

Steers over the age of 6 months may enter any section of the Show without a blood test.

ENTRY OF STOCK

- 1 Competition is not confined, and except in a few confined classes, is open to the United Kingdom.
- 2 Entries to the Secretary.
- 3 Entries should be made on the printed form available from the Secretary.
- 4 When an animal is to compete in 2 classes it must be entered in both. The Secretary must be informed when an animal is thus entered twice that only one stall shall be erected.
- 5 The classes for Cows in Milk and Cows in Calf are stated separately on the Premium List but where uncertainty exists at the time of entering as to whether the animals may be in milk or calf on show day, the entries will be repeated in both classes for the one entry payment.
- 6 Where age is not otherwise regulated, it is calculated from 1 January of year in which the animal was produced.
- 7 Except where otherwise provided, stock may be purchased up to last day of entry, but must be the bona fida property of the exhibitor, and have been in his possession from the last day of entry to day of show, and in case of sale, delivery must have been given and the price paid.
- 8 No animal to be shown from a stock in which any infectious disease has appeared within 3 months prior to the show.
- 9 All cattle being shown must be from a BVD negative herd or be blood tested clear of the disease. Pre entry would be appreciated as we have to check every animal.
- 10 The Committee accept no responsibility for any damage to modes of transport. Enter the show field at your own risk.

ENTRY MONEY

- 10 As per class.

ADMISSION AND PLACING OF STOCK

- 11 All stock admitted from 8.00-9.30 on show morning; bulls must be secured by a ring in the nose with a rope attached. Cattle and horses must have a leading halter in readiness for the parade of prize stock.

WITHDRAWAL OF STOCK

- 12 No stock can be withdrawn until after the prize parade on show day, and there must be no unstalling of stock prior to that event. All prize winners to parade otherwise prize money will be withheld.

JUDGING OF STOCK

- 13 Judging to commence at 10 am. JUDGES AND STEWARDS ASSEMBLE in the Secretary's office at 9.45 am.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 14 In cases of award to Cows in Calf or Mares in Foal, the Premium may be withheld until a Certificate of Produce can be obtained. Premiums will not be paid should deception have been attempted upon the Judge. The show committee reserve to themselves the right of refusing, cancelling or prohibiting the exhibition of entries from any person who has been expelled from membership of any Agricultural or Dairy Society or Breed Society in consequence of having attempted to obtain a prize by giving false certificate or by unfair means, or who is under exclusion from any Breed Society for fraudulent practices. The Committee shall also refuse to accept the nomination or appointment of any such person as Judge.

MINISTRY REGULATIONS

- 15 Sections for EBL attested cattle and MV attested sheep will be provided if required.
- 16 The Show Committee further reserve to themselves the right of refusing any other entries they think fit to exclude or to cancel any entry made, or to prohibit the exhibition of any entry.

REGULATIONS AS TO "DOCTORING"

- 17 The Report of the Committee's Veterinary Surgeon will be sufficient to warrant the Committee disqualifying any animal from competing, or if it has competed, from being awarded a prize or prizes if, in the Inspector's opinion any impropriety has been resorted to.
- 18 The Committee's Veterinary Inspector has been instructed to draw the teats of any cow in the Milk Classes in order to satisfy themselves that the teats are open and have not been tampered with in any way, also to examine the teats of cows in calf to see that they also have not been tampered with.

PROTESTS

- 19 Protests against awards must be lodged with the Secretary in writing on the show day, plus a deposit of £5. Protests must state the ground of objection and parties lodging them must substantiate their allegations before the Directors.
N.B.- All disputes regarding these rules or arising in any way in connection with the show to be settled by a Committee whose decision shall be final.

SHOW ARRANGEMENTS

At 2.00 pm on Show day every animal in the show field which has been awarded a prize or recommended will be paraded in front of the view stands. Each class to be admitted separately, all in order of merit. The caretakers of cattle and horses must be punctual in attendance at 1.30 pm.

INSTRUCTIONS TO COLLECTORS

Leaders of stock in all sections get in from 8.00 to 9.30 on Show morning, thus one leader to one haltered cow or horse, one to each lot of sheep and one to each lot of young cattle. After the stock has been placed no holder of any entry schedule gets free admission under any pretext till the show is over. To this the attention of the Collector is particularly called.

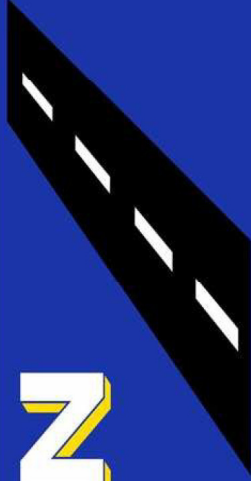
