PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL CLASSES MUST BE PRE-ENTRED AND PRE-PAID BY 8PM ON THURSDAY 4TH JUNE. ENTRIES SHOULD BE MADE VIA horsemonkey.com AND WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT REGISTRATION NUMBERS UNLESS JUMPING ON A TICKET.

Refund of Entry Fees – Affiliated shows are required to repay 50 % of the entry fees in respect of all entry cancellations which are received by the Show Organiser not later than 48 hours before noon of the day on which the first affiliated competition of the show is scheduled to start except in those circumstances outlined in Rule 79.5.

The Committee accept no responsibility for any damage to modes of transport. Enter the show field at your own risk.

Rules and Regulations

The judge's decision is final.

The Organisers will not accept any legal liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, riders, spectators or any property owned by them.

In accordance with Rule 82.20 no member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible to compete or be prepared to compete without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members are not at risk.

Riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted.

Practice fences will be flagged and must be jumped in the correct direction.

RING 1 SENIOR BRITISH SHOWJUMPING 9am prompt

ALL PERSONS SHOWING HORSES OR PONIES MUST ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

Class 1 - Arena 1 - KBIS Club - Senior 80cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. Only those combinations registered as Club members are eligible for points. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 combinations from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify in a maximum of two consecutive heights. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on

the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 2a - Arena 1 - Ariat Senior British Novice Championship First Round

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2022 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior British Novice Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6. Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class. Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice Championship - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Senior British Novice - Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Class 3a - Arena 1 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery - First Round

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2021 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Discovery Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship - Second Round. Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Senior Discovery Championships Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Pre-Entry

Championship Sash will be awarded to the winner of the class, kindly sponsored by Mtech 24/7.

Combinations must be in the Bronze league on the date of the show. Silver or Gold league riders are not eligible.

Prizes: 1st: £60.00, 2nd: £50.00, 3rd: £40.00, 4th: £30.00, 5th: £22.00, Total: £202.00.

Mounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 5 required)

Class 5 - Arena 1 - GFS Saddles Senior Newcomers Championship First Round / 1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

- Newcomers:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2020, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Championship - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April (subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

Open to all registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Those riders not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2026 will be eligible to qualify for the National 1.15m Members Cup Final. Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification period: 1st June-31st May. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)).

Pre-Entry

Championship Sash will be awarded to the winner of the class, kindly sponsored by West Kype farm livery yard.

Combinations must be in the Silver league on the date of the show, Gold league riders are not eligible.

Prizes: 1st: £75.00, 2nd: £65.00, 3rd: £50.00, 4th: £40.00, 5th: £25.00, Total: £255.00.

Class 7 - Arena 1 - Redpost Equestrian Senior Foxhunter - First Round /1.20M Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

Kindly sponsored by Redpost Equestrian Ltd In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

- Foxhunter:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2019, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April(subject to revision). Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2026 are not eligible for qualification to the 2027 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.20m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members. Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

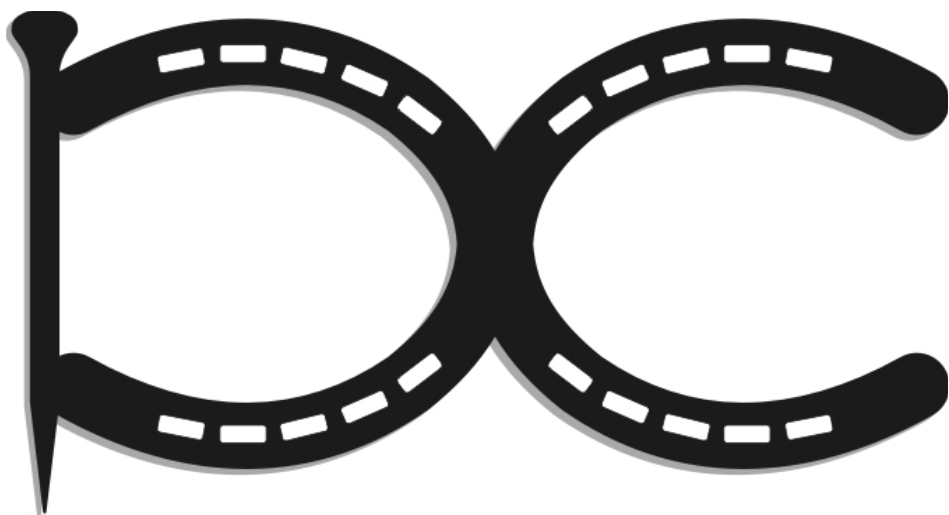
