Class 90 D&H/BHS Scotland RC Working Hunter Series 2026, over 15 hands. Jumps not exceeding 1m. To be eligible for the final the rider must be a BRC member.

Class 91 Perth Equine Vets/BHS Scotland Open Working Hunter Series 2026, over 15 hands. Jumps not exceeding 1.05 m

Class 92 Netherton Equestrian/BHS Scotland Riding Club Style Jumping Series

Classes 90-92 are qualifiers for the Scone Palace International Horse Trials. The first three prize winners of each class will qualify for the final of the named qualifier, which will be held at Scone Palace on Thursday 27th August 2026.

Style and performance

Riders jump one round and are judged on the style of their riding.

When jumping, the rider is judged on how they ride the whole course, particular attention being given to how they ride the turns and present the horse at a fence. The rider needs to show balanced approaches to the fences and be able to maintain a good forward canter in a rhythm. The position of the rider at take-off, in the air, on landing and in the following strides is assessed along with the correct judgement of pace. It is assumed that the rider is aware of the correct leading leg and is able to change it if needed (a flying change correctly and quietly done is acceptable as is a simple change through trot).

To be eligible for the final either the rider or the owner must be a member of the British Horse Society.

All ridden hunters must be shod all round. No pads or surgical shoes are allowed.

Training Stakes. Open to all heights of horses and ponies. Choose your own height. Body protectors are recommended.

Judging method: there will be an overall jumping mark plus a score for manners given for a short show straight after you have jumped.

- 2 A number will be allocated to each entry and should be displayed by a ticket attached to the rider.
- 3 ENTRY FEES must accompany the entry forms. Cheques should be crossed and made payable to LOUDOUN & GALSTON AGRICULTURAL ASSOCIATION SCIO. Entry Fees will only be returned if entry has to be cancelled prior to the day of the Show.
- 4 The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel or combine any classes in the event of insufficient entries.
- 5 **All persons showing horses or ponies must accept full responsibility and liability to the general public, and no animal should be shown which is not quiet in all traffic.**
- 6 The Judge's decision is final on all points. In the event of any query arising as to the age of a juvenile competitor, the Committee reserves the right to withhold any prize until a birth certificate has been produced.
- 7 Any objection that may arise must be lodged on the day of the Show at the Secretary's tent, accompanied by a deposit of £5.
- 8 In height classes, horse/pony will be measured, other than those holding JMS measurement certificates.
- 9 Hard hats must be worn and securely fastened at all times while mounted.
- 10 The Committee accept no responsibility for any damage to modes of transport. Enter the show field at your own risk.

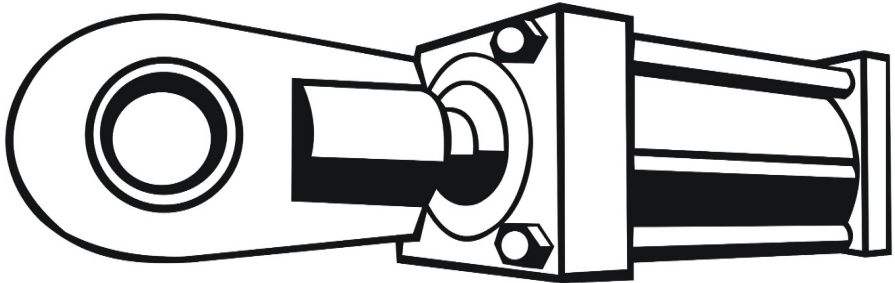
