RING 1 SENIOR BRITISH SHOWJUMPING 9am prompt

ALL PERSONS SHOWING HORSES OR PONIES MUST ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

Class 1 - 09:00 - Ring 1 - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds.
Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50, 2nd: £40, 3rd: £25, 4th: £20, 5th: £18.

Entry Fee = £18

Class 2 - Ring 1 - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2018 are not eligible for qualification to the 2019 Championship.

Open section:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50, 2nd: £40, 3rd: £25, 4th: £20, 5th: £18. Entry Fee = £18

Class 3 - Ring 1 - Senior 1.30m Open incorporating The Strathallan Castle RHS Young Masters Qualifier

Table A7 Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

Final kindly sponsored by Strathallan Events, Auchterarder.

Qualifying riders will be taken from designated 1.30m Open (Table A10 or Table A7) classes.

To be eligible to qualify, riders must be aged 25 years or under as of 1st January 2019. For registered horses of any grade to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. NB – Riders eligible for qualification must declare at time of entry.

The two highest placed eligible horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2019. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of 2 horses per rider.

SILVER SALVER presented by the late J Ness, Caterers (to be competed for annually).

Prizes: 1st: £100, 2nd: £80, 3rd: £55, 4th: £40, 5th: £25. Entry Fee = £20

Class 4 - Ring 1 - Graham Heath Equestrian Novice Championship Qualifier

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

For registered horses that have not won a total of 200 points to be ridden by Adult/Associate or Junior Member disregarding any rider on the Gold League list as of 31st March 2018 and any horse/rider combination on the Silver league list as at 31st March 2018.

Numbers to qualify: One double clear to qualify

This class can be run with an open, with two sets of prize money awarded & horses may compete in one section only

Class 5 - Ring 1 - 95cm Open Scope Championship Qualifier

Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members; excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League list as of 31st March 2018 and any horse /rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League list as of 31st March 2018.

Numbers to qualify: One double clears to qualify

Prizes: 1st: £30, 2nd: £25, 3rd: £20, 4th: £15.

Entry Fee = £14

Class 6 - Ring 1 - 1.00m Novice Scope Championship Qualifier

Rule 314. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

For registered horses that have not won a total of 225 points, to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Numbers to qualify: One double clear to qualify. Dual qualification for the Senior Discovery-horse age rules will apply.

This class cannot be incorporated into an open.

Prizes: 1st: £40, 2nd: £30, 3rd: £20, 4th: £18, 5th: £16.

Entry Fee = £16

Class 7 - Ring 1 - Senior 1.05m Open

Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Prizes: 1st: £40, 2nd: £30, 3rd: £20, 4th: £18, 5th: £16.

Entry Fee = £16

Rules and Regulations

The judge's decision is final.

The Organisers will not accept any legal liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, riders, spectators or any property owned by them.

In accordance with Rule 82.20 no member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible to compete or be prepared to compete without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members are not at risk.

Riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted.

Practice fences will be flagged and must be jumped in the correct direction.

RING 2 PONY BRITISH SHOWJUMPING 9am prompt

ALL PERSONS SHOWING HORSES OR PONIES MUST ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

Class 8 - 09:00 - Ring 2 - Pony British Novice First Round

Rule 410. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

For registered Ponies in Grade JD, that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds.

Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds.

If combined with an open: In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25, 2nd: £22, 3rd: £16, 4th: £12.

Entry Fee = £12

Class 9 - Ring 2 - Cats & Pipes Debut UK Championship Handicap Qualifier

Rule 414. Table A2. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 75cm / 85cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 138cm, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all, however for qualification purposes, those riders up to the end of the calendar year in which the age of 10 is reached are eligible to enter irrespective of points achieved. Riders aged 10 years and over on 1st January in the calendar year, must not have won a total of 350 points in the 128cm section and 700 points in the 138cm section.

Once riders have competed at, or "ever" qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final. Once a Pony has qualified with any rider for RIHS or HOYS in the current year, then it is not eligible to compete in this competition or the Final.

Qualifying period: 1st January - 31st July

Number to qualify: Two double clears will qualify ponies to the Debut Handicap Championship Final at the Scope Festival. Those pony/rider combinations who achieve two double clears (subject to revision) between 1st January-30th June will also qualify for the Stepping Stones Final at the British Showjumping National Championships, that is only if the riders are eligible to qualify for the Stepping Stones Final in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 414.1.

No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25, 2nd: £22, 3rd: £16, 4th: £12.

Entry Fee = £12

Class 10 - Ring 2 - Swn Y Mor 90cm Novice Masters UK Supreme Championship Qualifier

Rule 406. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Open to registered ponies that have not won a total of 300 Points, to be ridden by Pony Members, riders ages competing on 128/138cms ponies must be in accordance with rules 77.12/77.13.

Numbers to qualify: One double clear. Dual qualification for the Pony Discovery.(Riders who qualify are asked to email the Scope office at scope.office@btinternet.com)

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Classes 10 and 11 will run simultaneously where competitors will enter into either one of the classes.

MACDONALD TROPHY - presented by the MacDonald Family.

Prizes: 1st: £30, 2nd: £25, 3rd: £20, 4th: £15.

Class 11 - Ring 2 - 90cm Loudoun & Galston Small Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Classes 10 and 11 will run simultaneously where competitors will enter into either one of the classes.

Prizes: 1st: £30, 2nd: £25, 3rd: £20, 4th: £15.

Entry Fee = £14

Class 12 - Ring 2 - Graham Heath Equestrian (128/138cms) UK Championship Handicap Qualifier

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.00m / 1.05m.

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 128cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2007 and registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2005. Pony/Riders are not eligible to compete in this class before the calendar year of which their eighth birthday is reached.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears

No rider may ride more than three ponies in the same section, in accordance with rule 77.6

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

138cms winner- LOCHMILLS TEKOPERPETUAL TROPHY presented by the Ferrie Family, Ashyard, Hurlford.

First Three Pony/Rider Combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at RHS 2019 Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of two ponies per rider.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £50, 2nd: £35, 3rd: £30, 4th: £20, 5th: £18.

Entry Fee = £18

Class 14 - Ring 2 - The Sign Co. And Danny's Snacks 138cm Pony Royal Highland Show Championship Qualifier

Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

Open to registered ponies exceeding 128cms and not exceeding 138cms to be ridden by Junior Members in accordance with rule 77.12

First three pony/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at RHS 2019. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of two ponies per rider.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £50, 2nd: £35, 3rd: £30, 4th: £20, 5th: £18.

Entry Fee = £18.

Class 15 - Ring 2 - Kierson Restoration Pony Bright Star Championship Qualifier

Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Open to registered ponies exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms irrespective of points, to be ridden by Junior Members, disregarding those riders on the 148cms Gold League List as of March 31st 2018 or any rider/pony combination having ever qualified for RIHS or HOYS on a 148cms.

Numbers to qualify: - One double clear

(Riders who qualify are asked to email the Scope office at scope.office@btinternet.com)

This class can be run with a 148cms Open section, with two sets of prize money awarded, ponies can only enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30, 2nd: £25, 3rd: £20, 4th: £15.

Class 16 - Ring 2 - The Sign Co. And Danny's Snacks 148cm Pony Royal Highland Show Championship Qualifier

Open to registered ponies exceeding 138cms and not exceeding 148cms to be ridden by Junior members.

First Three Pony/Rider Combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at RHS 2019. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of two ponies per rider.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 148cms in Grades JD/JC to be ridden by Junior Members. First three pony /rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at RHS 2019. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of two ponies per rider.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

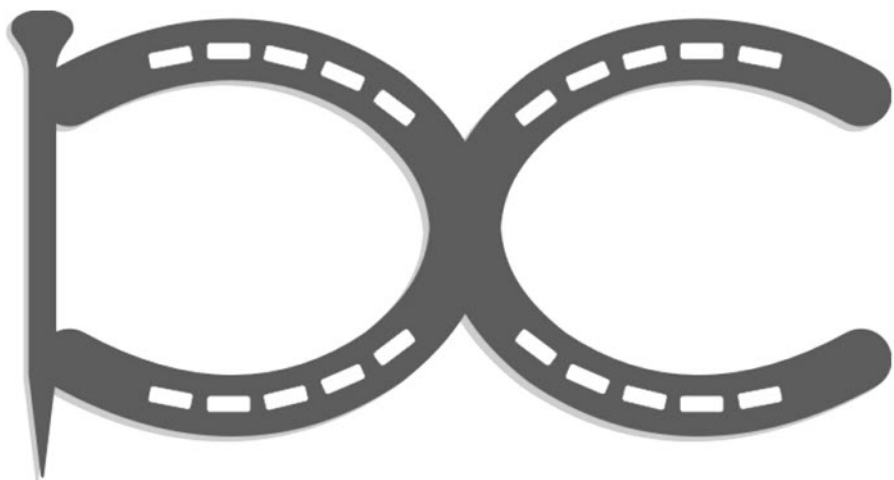
